WHITE WINE

BURGUNDIES

2013 Saint Veran, Domaine Gueugnon-Remond Charnay-Les-Macon £32.00

This wine will appeal to you in its early years by the finesse and silkiness on the palate and delicacy will give you pleasure for 5 or 6 years. The feminine touch of the wine making, gives to this wine an extraordinary elegance and excellent concentration

2012 Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru Domaine Jean-Marc Pillot £210.00

Jean-Marc Pillot started working for the family Domaine in 1985 under Jean, his father, before taking the reins in 1991. He is one of the fifth generation of Pillots cultivating wines in Chassagne. These wines possess everything- richness and depth of fruit, the classic firmness of the great Chassagne and a long, smooth finish

2014 Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Les Frionnes Domaine Sylvain Langoureau £49.00

With a production of 550 cases a year only, these wines are elegant gems and very limited. The winery is essentially a garage and a cellar and everything is done by hand and care. There is a light minerality suffusing the rich and generously proportioned middle weight flavours that possess good verve and tension on the delicious finish; generous, subtly-oaked, well-balanced acidity

2011 Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Les Champs Gain, Domaine Jean-Marc Pillot £102.00

There is a stylish balance between power and elegance on the palate with steely acidity pinioning the ripe pineapple and juicy peach flavours. There are graceful touches of oak to be found here too, with dried nuts and honey adding complexity and lending their weight through the dry, crisp, flinty finish

2015 Chablis Louis Moreau £32.00

Domaine Louis Moreau was born from the passion of a family settled in Chablis in 1814. Louis Moreau, who has been heading the domain since 1994, elaborates wines of unique style, combining minerality, fineness, elegance and purity. This Chablis shows a nice brilliant golden colour, while its nose is floral with a hint of white fruit (apple, pear). According to the vintage, its gustatory attack can express mineral and citrus notes, balanced by its roundness and fineness

2014 Chablis 1er Cru Les Fourneaux L. Moreau £48.00

We can notice notes of white flowers, such as acacia and rose petals, along with a discreet vanilla aroma. It is a very round in mouth, with a hint of acidity that allows it to keep its minerality. This rich and round wine will go best with a slightly spicy dish or a white meat with sauce

2014 Meursault Les Vireuils, Domaine Michel Dupont-Fahn £55.00

The wines have a unique “forward” style, which sets them apart from the rest. Late harvesting and early bottling lead to extremely rich and buttery wine, high in alcohol and generous ripe fruits and minerality notes with a touch of wood. The palate is rich with a fresh low acidity



LOIRE & ALSACE

2014 Gewurztraminer Trimbach £35.00

The vineyards of Alsace snuggle in the shelter of the Vosges Mountains in eastern France. Gewürztraminer wines produced there are heady with a perfume and flavour so full that the wines often give an impression of sweetness even though they are quite dry

2015 Kritt Gewurztraminer Les Charmes £55.00

The bottling was made the 8th of September. It's one of our smallest production due to the weather conditions -3900 bottles only. It is a slightly sweet gewürztraminer, with only 8 g of residual sugar. It is a gastronomic wine, with elegant litchi and flowers notes and also a fine acidity, which belong to this vintage

2016 Sancerre Domaine Michel Girard £36.50

This wine shows pure Sauvignon style - fragrant aromas of apple and citrus with a waft of mineral pungency, all backed up with lovely weight and fresh clean acidity

2015 Muscadet Sevre et Maine sur Lie Aux Avineaux, Gadais Pere et Fils £28.00

Our wine is aged on its lees for up to 6 months. This traditional 'sur lie' maturation results in a Muscadet, that is crisp and fresh, yet with a certain richness. Perfect with shellfish and seafood or as an aperitif

2009 Clos du Val D'Eleon Riesling/Pinot Gris Organic, Domaine Marc Dreydenwess £49.00

The vintage 2009 – hot and sunny year – seems to suit to the wines produced on Terroir like schist. The first nose is powerful, stone and spices together, and also some delicate smoked notes. The mouth is rich and generous. It's a straight wine with an impressive salinity. The balanced is perfect and powerful

BORDEAUX AND LANGUEDOC

2015 Dourthe No 1 Sauvignon Blanc, Bordeaux £25.00

This is a very enjoyable wine, with its impressive full palette of aromas, which range from the freshness of lemon and grapefruit zest to the intensity of passion fruits. The wine is rounded and bursting with fresh fruit character, with a delicious long finish

2014 Picpoul de Pinet La Comtesse, Languedoc £29.00

Soft, delicate nose, with pleasant hints of Mediterranean white peach, apricots and zesty lime peel. Delicate and fresh in the mouth and it has an excellent vibrant acidity

RIAS BAIXAS

2015 Albariño Davila DOC Rías Baixas Adegas Valmiñor £32.00

On the nose, DAVILA shows a wide and complex range of spring-flower aromas, highlighting notes of pineapple and mango. In the mouth, it is velvety and fresh with a good structure. It passes with delicacy filling the palate with a complex load of tropical fruits intermingled with aromatic herbs



VENEZIA - GIULIA

2015 Pinot Grigio Borgo delle Oche IGT £24.00

Borgo delle Oche officially opened in 2004, but the quality and consistency of their wines has seen them receive several mentions in Gambero Rosso, the foremost authority on Italian wine. Wine has a pretty and fruity nose and considerable richness and complexity in the mouth, while pear and apple notes shine on the fruity palate

DEVON

2014 Bacchus Kenton Vineyard £31.00

As well as being the fourth most planted grape variety in England, Bacchus is the ancient Roman name for the classical god of wine. Planted in 2003 on an old farm, the south facing slopes and sandy soil together with the mild and sunny climate are ideal for growing vines and ripening grapes for wine production. This small, family-owned, boutique winery produces wines that sell out fast with every vintage release. This is highly aromatic dry wine with classic Bacchus elder flower and crisp fruit notes

REST OF THE WORLD

2014 Director's Cut Chardonnay Francis Ford Coppola, Russian River Valley, California £49.00

“Wine making and filmmaking are two great art forms that are very important in the development of California.

They both start with raw ingredients –in the case of wine, the land and the grapes, and in the case of film, the script and the actors’ performances. The winemaker takes these raw materials and ferments and blends.

He says yes to one batch, no to another. The director does the same thing: a series of yeses and no’s, from casting and costuming to edits and sound mixes.”-Francis Ford Coppola. We crush the grapes whole-cluster and ferment entirely in French oak barrels to produce a wine with a seductive, round texture and notes of sweet vanilla. This technique also serves to highlight the green apple, honeysuckle and citrus flavours, which are the hallmark of Russian River vineyards.

Full-bodied and impeccably balanced

2015 Sauvignon Blanc Mount Vernon, New Zealand £25.00

This wine is simply trying to express the characters of the vineyards.

Grapes carefully pressed and fermented at cool temperatures with aromatic yeast strains.

The fruit from each vineyard is fermented separately and a final selection for the finished wine was made prior to bottling. This is Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc at its best- zesty, crisp, herbaceous and tropical

2016 Sauvignon Blanc Grover Vineyards, India £24.00

Grover vineyards launched its wines in 1992 and is today the oldest surviving winery in India.

Refreshing mouth-feel and shows intense floral and grapefruit aromas with a hint of guava & dried fruits, that brings complexity. The crisp acidity enhances the lingering taste of a well-structured wine

2016 Chenin Blanc, Kleine Zalze Barrel Fermented Stellenbosch, South Africa £24.00

On the nose, there are concentrated aromas of peach, lime and litchi fruit with hints of sweet melon and well balanced French oak wood flavours. Ripe layers of fruit, both combined with subtle wood give this wine a good length of fruit and creamy mouth feel, with an elegant acidity in the background



RED WINE

BORDEAUX

2002 Chateau Grand Corbin Saint-Emilion Grand Cru £61.00

. Alain Giraud bought Chateau Grand Corbin in 1960 and today, the estate is still managed and owned by the same family. The chateau was designed by the same architect as Chateau l'Evangile in Pomerol and is one of the oldest estate in St. Emillion. Vintage 2000 was quite special in Bordeaux. Across the board, the wine boasts ripe succulent fruit and fine, firm, tannins with many displaying the structure, depth and length that mark out truly great claret. Revealing flavours of plums, wood smoke and black berries

2011 Chateau Saint-Georges Saint-Emilion £55.00

A few miles from the magical town of Saint Emilion stands the majestic Château Saint Georges. With the commanding symmetry of the castle's Louis XVI architecture, the Château breathes elegance and harmony. With its generous character, full-bodied flavour, rich bouquet and propensity for perfect aging, Chateau Saint Georges ranks among the first class wines of France's Bordeaux region. Palate is rich with red fruits and notes of liquorice with silky smooth tannins

2011 Chateau Mille Roses, Haut-Medoc £65.00

Mille Roses is a small family-owned estate, that has created such a buzz among France's sommelier community. Raspberries and marzipan on the nose with dense layers of very fine tannins on a medium body with lovely freshness. Serious, but with a very light touch

2012 Chateau des Gravieres, Graves £39.50

Merlot dominating blend is deep garnet-red with a slightly woody on a nose with aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced in the mouth with a firm, lengthy finish

2012 Chateau Brio de Cantenac Brown, Margaux £70.00

This wine is velvety and smooth with classic cedar and some chocolate hints. Finesse and strength are the main values of this wine, ready to drink before, during and after any meal

2008 Chateau Rauzan-Segla 2e Cru Classe, Margaux £135.00

Vibrant purple in colour, the wine is packed with liquorice, black currants and cherries with elements of smoke. It possess a lovely texture, a round mouth feel, sweet tannins and low acidity. Classic, approachable claret style

2012 Chateau de Ricaud, Cadillac £35.00

Deep in appearance with ruby tones. The complex bouquet reveals ripe fruit aromas of strawberry and cherry, together with a hint of liquorice. Very generous on the palate, structured by lovely rounded tannins, evolving towards a long, savoury finish with well-integrated oak character



BURGUNDY

2011 Nuits-Saint Georges 1er Cru Vignes Rondes, Domaine Daniel Rion et Fils £96.00

As its name indicates, it presents great roundness and smoothness, reminiscent of wines closer to Vosne Romanée. It is characterized by a marked blackcurrant nose, which is fruity exuberant. Its suppleness does not prevent it from having great depth, it is in fact a powerful wine, with excellent aging potential

2012 Gevrey-Chambertin Organic “Cuvea Ostrea” Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Trapet £90.00

Ostrea is an unique wine from the Trapet family’s oldest wines, originally planted in 1913. It is a wine with generous layers of dark and red berries, silky tannins with a long finish

2015 Fleurie Les Granits Roses, Domaine Jean-Marc Lafont £37.50

100% Gamay grape from Beaujolais. Damson, juicy - complex with lots of spice and white pepper, very nice texture and lovely finish

RHONE

2013 Chateauneuf-Du-Pape Chante Cigale £55.00

Bright ruby in colour. Dark berry and cherry pit aromas are lifted by notes of fresh lavender and white pepper. The palate is rich and ripe with layers of dark fruits and touch of liquorice, supported by fine tannins

2013 Cotes Du Rhone Pure Garrigue, Domaine de la Renjarde £28.00

The hill protecting La Renjarde is “Pure Garrigue”- a home to Provençal herbs crickets and dry, sandy soil with patches of white limestone. If you visited us on a summer evening, your senses would quickly be surrounded with the mixed fragrant aromas and scents of our parched landscape: thyme, rosemary, laurel and sun drenched stones. When opening this bottle, you will find a bit of “Pure Garrigue”. Fruity aromas of raspberries and dark cherries swirl around the glass, together with hints of dried herbs and earthiness underlined by soft fine tannins

LANGUEDOC

2015 Pinot Noir Fat Bastard, Thierry & Guy £22.00

Sourced from selected vineyards amidst the foothills of the Missif Central near the beautiful communes of Pézenas and Narbonne, Fat bastard Pinot Noir is a brilliant expression of the land from which it is made. The relatively high altitudes of the vineyards, provide the optimal temperate conditions necessary for aroma and colour development in the wine. Bright, ruby red colour with intense and elegant notes of crushed strawberries and wild raspberries followed by a long, smooth finish



TOSCANA

2015 Chianti, Conti Serristori D.O.C £24.00

To say Serristori means Florence. This great family has played a part in the splendours of the Signoria and has had talented men in all fields. Conti Serristori's vocation for Tuscan wines is inspired by the ideal of perfection of the Florentine Renaissance. This wine is ruby red in colour with an intense and fragrant bouquet, with gentle hints of raspberries, wild strawberries and violets. The flavour is dry, full-bodied and harmonious with a distinguished background of blackberry and almonds

2007 Brunello di Montalcino, Poggio Antico £103.00

Beautiful aromas of wild ripe red berries, leather and spices as Poggio Antico's 2007 Brunello di Montalcino opens up in the glass. Powerful, big, round, yet extremely elegant with great balance, velvety sweet tannins and very persistent in the finish

2009 Orma Bolgheri IGT £90.00

Super Tuscan": is a term used to describe some of the most innovative and superlative red wines from the Tuscany region in Italy. The Super Tuscan movement began in the late 1960s, when a few forward thinking wine makers in the Chianti region broke with tradition to create wines, that did not conform to the strict regulations of the time by using unauthorised grape varieties and/or non-traditional oak barrels for aging. The resulting wines attracted international attention and are considered to be some of the finest wines produced in Italy.

The bouquet recalls ripe red fruit and blackberries, with notes of Mediterranean vegetation and eucalyptus and a subtle nuance of baked bell peppers from the component varieties. Its rich, layered flavours and roundness are sustained by a vibrant, vivid freshness and sweet, well balanced, perfectly integrated tannins

2013 Crognolo Tenuta Sette Ponti IGT £55.00

Crognolo is named after a wild bush Cornus, that grows abundantly on the estate. It is a fruity wine, emphasized by the rich scent of Sangiovese, which recalls the scent of ripe cherries and elegance of aging in oak

PIEMONTE

2011 Barolo Cannubi E. Pira £103.50

The intense and brilliant colour perfectly expresses the polyphenols of a very successful Nebbiolo. 2011 Barolo Cannubi is a model of pure grace. Silky and precise, is laced with sweet red berries, crushed flowers, spices and mint. All the elements fall into place in a wine of total finesse and elegance



VENETO

2014 Mara Valpolicella, Ripasso Superiore £42.00

Valpolicella Superiore obtained from Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes grown in the vineyards on the Valpolicella hills, exposed to south and planted in the most suitable locations. In the month of January following the harvest, the wine undergoes a second light fermentation carried on the Amarone grapes residues after pressing. The result is a full-bodied, warm and velvety wine with intense aromatic bouquet of ripe cherries

2007 Amarone Classico, Bertani £140.00

Amarone Classico Bertani is a timeless wine, in the unique style that Bertani has always striven care to preserve.

It is a perfect example of total harmony between time, nature and man, and to it we devote all our skill and enthusiasm, all our patience and loving care. This Amarone is surprising for the intensity at the nose.

The notes of red berries are overpowered by an extremely rich bouquet, that it highlights intense aroma of cherries, mingled with notes of vanilla and an agreeable trace of spiciness. In the mouth, it is dense, thanks to the velvety and round tannins

RIOJA AND RIVERA DEL DUERO

2006 Marques de Riscal Gran Reserva, Rioja £70.00

Aromas of sun-dried fruit combine with hints of vanilla on the nose. Sweet and savoury sensations fill the mouth, leaving behind a touch of caramel and wild cherries on the finish. Velvety tannins add balance and texture

2011 Marques de Murrieta Rioja Reserva £35.00

Bodegas Marques de Murrieta is the oldest of the historic, top class Riojan bodegas and was established in 1852 by Luciano F. Ramon de Murrieta. It is impressive wine with its outstanding aromatics of cherry and red fruit, mineral smoke and subtle oak notes. On the palate, it reveals fleshy fruit, silky tannins and spicy oak

2010 Ribera Del Duero Pago de los Capellanes, El Nogal £85.00

A serious, multi-faceted wine with a long life ahead. Floral aromas and fresh black fruit fills the nose followed by a complex palate of vanilla, cocoa, toasted coffee and new leather, displaying a fine balance of oak and fruit.

Superb length with lasting notes of spice, tobacco, sandalwood and liquorice

ALENTEJO AND DOURO

2013 Esporao Reserva Tinto, Alentejo £45.00

Classic wine style made from estate grown grapes that shows the consistency and the rich, ripe fruit characters which are typical of the best Alentejo red wines. Our wine has intense spicy aroma of mature red berry fruits with discrete oak complexity. Compact, elegant, dense and creamy. Firm tannins offering structure for bottle maturation

2013 Douro Crasto Superior, Quinta Do Crasto Douro £32.00

Located on the right bank of the Douro River, between the towns of Régua and Pinhão, Quinta do Crasto is a property of 130 hectares, 70 of which are planted with vines. Nestled on a privileged location in the Douro Demarcated Region, Quinta do Crasto has belonged to the family of Leonor and Jorge Roquette for over a century and like all the great properties of the Douro, it dates back to ancient times - the name "Crasto" is derived from the Latin word "castrum", which means "Roman fort". The wine has beautifully perfumed fruit and spice aromas. It is intense and vibrant, with velvety texture and so-subtle oakiness

2013 Director's Cut Cabernet Sauvignon Francis Ford Coppola, Alexander Valley £55.00

Enjoy a luscious palate of blackberries, cherries, and cassis along with fragrant earthy minerals and notes of anise and cocoa.

As the flavours build and flow, a toasted caramel impression at the end creates an alluring finish

2013 Pinot Noir Falcon's Perch, J. Lohr Estate Monterey, USA £29.00

This region has earned a well-deserved reputation for producing world-class Pinot Noir.

The 2013 J. Lohr Estates Falcon's Perch Pinot Noir offers mixed, ripe notes of black cherry, strawberry and dried herbs lifted by vanilla spice. Plump red fruit on the palate finishes with a touch of talc and rhubarb

2012 Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Ste Michelle, Indian Wells, Washington Estate, USA £35.00

Founded in 1934, Chateau Ste. Michelle is the oldest winery in Washington with some of the most mature vineyards in the Columbia Valley. The winery combines Old World wine making with New World innovation.

The Indian Wells Cabernet is our warm climate ripe, jammy "New World" style of Cabernet Sauvignon.

The wine typifies the Wahluke Slope region with dark fruit aromas and flavours. Syrah added an enhanced richness and concentration to the wine. Silky tannins, all backed by a finish of bittersweet chocolate

2013 Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz "La Reserve", Grover Vineyards, India £26.50

La Réserve has a powerful bouquet of luscious ripe red and black fruits with an exquisite hint of spice. It combines grace and splendour on the palate with chocolate, coffee beans and vanilla flavours. The finish is long, ample and almost magical

2013 Malbec Clos de Los Siete, Argentina £27.00

Michel Rolland, unavoidable oenologist coming from the greatest castles in Bordeaux, with his 6 friends owns the Clos de Los Siete, situated in the south of Mendoza. This wine unleashes its complex, delicious bouquet of ripe grapes, while spicy, peppery notes reveal Malbec as the unquestionable star of this blend. Roasted notes reveal well-handled oak-aging. Generous and well balanced on the palate, concentrated, yet silky velvet tannins bring elegant structure to the wine

2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva, Luis Felipe, Chile £26.50

It is beautifully dense, dark and brooding wine. Lightly oaked and showing typically rich notes of cassis, black cherry, mocha, cedar and a touch of mint, this really is a deliciously juicy wine

2011 Shiraz D'Arenberg, Wild Pixie, McLaren Valley, Australia £33.00

The Wild Pixie has unmistakable connection with the earth from which it emerged. Initially, it appears savoury and spicy with a whiff of 'funkiness', think fennel, black olive, bitter chocolate and earth. Given a moment to relax in the glass, we are struck by the nuances of plums, blackberries and mulberries that build and wood spice and vanilla notes

Layer upon layer of flavours carried along by a wave of mouth watering tannins that draws you in for another look



SWEET WINE

2008 Chateau Suduiraut 1er Cru Classe Sauternes 37.5cl £55.00

Classed as a Premier Cru in 1855, it is made from grapes selected from the finest *terroirs* of the property. This wine is hand crafted at every stage of its elaboration and reveals remarkable finesse and complexity and a golden colour reminiscent of the sun that made it possible. With age the bright gold evolves to a dark amber colour. With an extensive life-span, it powerfully and harmoniously combines fruit and floral aromas with roasted and candied notes

Muscat de Rivesaltes, Domaine Lerys 50cl £28.00

100% Muscat petits grains, causing the sensation of biting into a grape on the vine, very fruity and well balanced, it is ideal as an aperitif on fruit salads or chocolate desserts

2012 Bertani, Recioto Valpolicella DOCG 50cl £40.00

Bertani produces Recioto, a sweet red wine, with the Corvina and Rondinella grapes from the hills of the Valpantena, the same varieties used for Amarone. It is made from the smallest bunches with the best exposure to the sun, which are dried for about three months on the traditional “arèle”, or cane mats. The typical cherry bouquet is enhanced by the fact that the wine is matured in cherry-wood casks until it becomes a concentrate of wild marasca and visciola cherries. The result is dense and velvety, but never cloying

2013 Peller Family Estates, Riesling Ice wine VQA Niagara Peninsula 37.5cl £52.00

Pedro Ximenez La cigarrena NV D.O. Sanlucar/Xerez £34.00

The Pedro Ximénez La Cigarrera is a sweet wine made from 100% Pedro Ximénez grapes. These grapes undergo a process known as “sunning”, which means drying them on the sun in the open land, until the grapes turn into raisin. Musts obtained after pressing, obtaining high levels of sugar and a certain degree of colouring. In the nose it is intense, with raisin and nutty aromas. In the palate, it is full bodied, luscious and intense in the raisin and nutty/sweet flavours. It displays a prolonged finish with Christmas pudding reminiscences
