



SUITE SAUSALITO

Sausalito may not boast the excitement of neighboring San Francisco but a new, two-bedroom, two-and-a-half-bath Alexandrite Suite at Casa Madrona Hotel & Spa brings sizzle to the quiet town in Marin County. Bold and dazzling with floor-to-ceiling glass patio doors, this spectacular sanctuary, part of the hotel's newly renovated historic mansion built in 1885, offers 3,500 square feet of indoor living space and 1,500 square feet of outdoor, waterfront entertaining on a deck with a bar, hot tub, fire pit, and Wolf barbecue grill. Stunning views of the San Francisco skyline, Richardson Bay, and Bay Bridge highlight this suite, which counts a dedicated concierge, personal chef, complimentary transportation in a bio-diesel Mercedes-Benz ML350, and access to a double-mast schooner among its perks. The suite also includes an office, fitness center, dining area with a 10seat table, and open kitchen outfitted with Viking appliances. A bulletproof door leads to a room that can be used as a safe. The latest technology includes a media wall of nine Samsung Smart TVs, each measuring 55 inches that can show one mega image or nine individual images. Nine additional bedrooms are spread over the second and third floors while a new, 1,100 square-foot event space, Junto, with the same jaw-dropping views and a 600-square-foot deck sits below the Alexandrite Suite and is available for \$5,000 a day. Or book the Alexandrite Suite for \$10,000 nightly or the suite plus nine guestrooms and Junto for \$25,000 a day.

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
