



## Top Wedding Venues in Marin County, California

Completely restored in 2013, the mansion encompasses a 5,000-square-foot indoor/outdoor sleek space for stylish weddings. On the National Register of Historic Places, no detail has been overlooked in designing the gorgeous Alexandrite Suite with its floor-to-ceiling glass windows to bring the outdoors in. A full kitchen, outdoor grill, fire pit, private fitness room and two terraces are the centerpiece of the mansion and additional cottage accommodation tucked into the hillside. On the same property, Casa Madrona Hotel and Spa has a total of 63 bedrooms and an award-winning spa. Dock your sailboat right out the front door or hop aboard for one of the world's best ferry rides. Mediterranean-style restaurants and shops line the sidewalks here in the heart of Sausalito.
