A California hotel is taking luxurious amenities to new heights.


The new posh Mansion at Casa Madrona in Sausalito is offering drone champagne delivery service to guests staying in the \$10,000-a-night Alexandrite Suite.

A customized octo-copter drone will drop off two bottles of chilled bubbly on the 5,000-square-foot suite's two-tiered deck, which has stunning views of Richardson Bay and the San Francisco skyline.

The drone service is also available to high rollers who rent out the entire 11-bedroom Mansion for a cool \$25,000 a night.
